HOW TO BECOME A TALL CEDAR-AT-LARGE

Any Master Mason who resides one hundred (100) or more miles from the nearest Constituent Forest and is in good standing within a Masonic Lodge recognized by the Grand Lodge of his state which recognizes the Tall Cedars of Lebanon of North America may be made a Tall Cedar of Lebanon "Member-at-Large" upon meeting the following conditions.

1. Submit a completed petition to the Supreme Scribe along with one year's dues of thirty-five dollars (\$35.00) and a pyramid fee of fifty-five dollars (\$55.00)
2. The Petition shall be presented at the next Supreme Board of Directors meeting where it will be read and voted upon by that body. Any candidate receiving two (2) or more negative votes shall be declared rejected. The names of candidates so rejected shall not again be presented to that body until at least six (6) months have elapsed from the date of rejection and all monies paid shall be refunded.
3. The Annual dues of a "Member-at-Large" shall be thirty-five (\$35.00) dollars and will be sent to the Supreme Scribe who will issue the Dues card bearing the legend "Member-at-Large", and shall be recognized by all Forests.
4. A new "Member-at-Large" shall be initiated and given the Secret Work by the Supreme Tall Cedar or a Supreme Forest Officer designated by the Supreme Tall Cedar.
5. The initiation and instruction in the Secret Work shall take place at a site and time agreed upon by the Supreme Tall Cedar or his designee and the new "Member-at-Large."
6. Failure on the part of the new "Member-at-Large" to present himself within twelve (12) months of being accepted into the Tall Cedars of Lebanon of North America will result in his forfeiture of all monies paid by him.
7. A "Member-at-Large" that ceases to be a Master Mason in good standing, shall automatically be suspended and the Supreme Scribe shall strike his name from the roster.
8. A "Member-at-Large" shall be subject to all of the conditions set forth in the Supreme Forest By-laws pertaining to any Member of a Constituent Forest not specifically stated in this section.
