**Board of Directors Meeting**  
**March 8, 2014**

Problems continue with Forests that do not file Form 990 with the IRS.

Further research by SD Mark Brumaghim revealed that all items of concern on the Pennsylvania Small Games of Chance Legislation have now been either modified or removed. Therefore the Board has decided to again hold the Gun Raffle. The location will be at Gratz Fairgrounds and the date will be on August 23, 2014. Tickets will be run and will be distributed as soon as possible. The price per ticket will be \$10.00 with \$1.00 going back to the Forest for each ticket sold as in the past.

The Tall Cedar exhibit at the GWMM was again brought to the floor for discussion. After considerable discussion, the Board thought that the advantage to the Tall Cedars by having this publicity and recognition outweighed the cost involved. A motion was approved to renew our display for a period of two years at a cost not to exceed \$5,000.00 per year.

Eternal Flame at Masonic Village; a walkway and monument are being planned to honor all veterans that have served their country. To that end, the Board agreed to place a “brick” in the walkway demonstrating our support in this worthwhile venture. A similar action was taken to support the Grand Lodge of Georgia Children’s Garden by the purchase of a “paver”.

A question arose concerning clarification on Tall Cedar Aprons. While they are available from certain vendors, the membership should realize that they are not part of the official dress code.

As an item of interest, the Cedar Digest was announced as being at the printer.
